

Dear Parents and Carers,

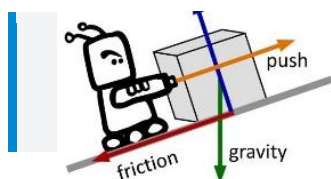
We hope you had a wonderful summer filled with fun, laughter, and exciting adventures. Whatever you got up to, we are delighted to welcome you to Year 5!
